Ingole v. Parrish & Guerriero

Election Supervisory Board Resolution: 2026-004
In Res. Failure to Submit Financial Disclosure

Election Supervisory Board Chairman, Samuel J. Hecht, delivered the majority opinion of the board:

“In the matter of an Executive Alliance failing to submit Financial Disclosure #1.”

On Tuesday, February 24, 2026, at 5:41 P.M. CST, Daksh Ingole submitted a complaint (Complaint ID: 4) against the Executive Alliance, Armando Parrish, and Benjamin Guerriero, alleging that they failed to submit Financial Disclosure #1 as required pursuant to **Title II, Chapter VI, Subchapter C, §6.16 (a) Campus-Wide Election Code:**

*“**CAMPAIGN EXPENDITURE RECORDS.** Each candidate must keep accurate and up-to-date records of all campaign receipts and expenditures. A template for financial disclosures for use by all candidates will be developed by the Election Supervisory Board and provided to each group by the first day of filing.”*

Upon further review, the Election Supervisory Board has determined that Parrish & Guerriero Executive Alliance successfully submitted Financial Disclosure #1 via the Dean of Students Campus-Wide Election Webpage on February 15, 2026, at 11:25 P.M. CST, which was prior to the deadline of February 16, 2026, at 4:30 P.M. CST.

Additionally, the board has determined that a technical issue is preventing the names “Armando Parrish and Benjamin Guerriero” from appearing under the “Candidate” section of the “View Financial Disclosures” webpage. However, these names are clearly visible once you select “details” on the first row of the webpage, where a white box currently appears in the “Candidate” space.

Finally, the complainant, Daksh Ingole, later admitted in Complaint ID: 6 that *“After further investigation, my previous complaint failed to see that the candidates had in fact submitted a financial disclosure.”*

Based on these facts, the Election Supervisory Board is not holding a hearing on this complaint brought forth against and is dismissing pursuant to Title II, Chapter IV, Subchapter A, §4.3 (b) Campus-Wide Election Code.

*“**RESPONDING TO COMPLAINTS.** The Election Supervisory Board shall act on all complaints within two days after they are received by either dismissing the complaint or calling a hearing under the provisions of this subchapter.*

- (b) *The complaint fails to state a cause of action for which relief may be granted; or.”*
